**ORDER**

On March 9, 2005, the plaintiffs’ filed a motion for a temporary restraining order seeking to prevent the defendants from using their images in an advertising campaign. The Court heard arguments on the plaintiffs’ motion on March 9 and March 10, 2005.<sup>1</sup> At the conclusion of the March 10, 2005 hearing, this Court granted the plaintiffs’ motion from the bench. For the reasons set forth by the Court at the conclusion of the hearing and to be further articulated in the Court’s Memorandum Opinion that will be issued shortly hereafter, is hereby this 14th day of March, 2005,

**ORDERED** that the plaintiffs motion for a temporary restraining order is **GRANTED**. It is further

**ORDERED** that the defendants, their officers, principals, agents, servants, employees, successors, and assigns shall not directly or indirectly distribute, publicly display, transmit, offer, advertise, market, or otherwise exploit, by any means, any material or product, in any form,

bearing any unauthorized reproduction, imitation, or simulation, in whole or in part, of the likeness of the plaintiffs, including but not limited to the plaintiffs' images defined in their complaint. It is further

**ORDERED** that the defendants, their officers, principals, agents, servants, employees, successors, and assigns shall not cause, contribute to, enable, facilitate or participate in any of the conduct described above.<sup>2</sup> It is further

**ORDERED** that, pursuant to Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 65, this Order shall expire on March 20, 2005.<sup>3</sup> It is further

**ORDERED** that consistent with this Order the plaintiffs shall post with the Clerk of the Court security in the amount of \$500.00.

<sup>2</sup> The plaintiffs also seek an order compelling the defendants to provide to the plaintiffs every electronic and hard copy of the plaintiffs' image or likeness that the defendants have in their possession and a list of all persons to whom the likeness of the plaintiffs was given. This Court will address these requests when it rules on the plaintiffs' motion for a preliminary injunction.

<sup>3</sup> Rule 65(b) provides that temporary restraining orders shall not exceed ten days. Because this Court granted the plaintiffs' motion for a temporary restraining order from the bench on March 10, 2005, that is when the ten day period began to run.
